

J.C.H.S. Bed Races
Held during Crossroads Cruz-In
Saturday, July 31st, 2010
4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

PARTICIPANTS

- *Businesses, families, churches, clubs, block groups, etc. are welcome.*
- *Entry Fee \$25.00 (Payable to the Johnson Creek Historical Society)*

REGULATIONS

- *Team Entry Forms must be turned in by July 24th, 2010.*
- *Team Waiver must be turned in with the entry form.*
- *Entry Fee turned in with entry form.*
- *Prizes will be awarded for the Fastest, Best Decorated Bed, Peoples Choice, and Most Likely to Break Down entry.*
- *Team members must be 18 years of age to participate.*

Note: Your safety is very important to us. Please wear good running shoes. All entries must sign a Team Waiver, accepting their own liability.

RULES OF THE RACE

- *Each team must have 5 people to a team (4 runners and 1 rider)*
- *Each team will be required to attend a safety meeting at 3:30 p.m.*
- *The race will take place at the intersection of Midge St. and the Centennial Park driveway.*
- *Runners & Rider must be dressed according to the theme of Cruz-In..*
- *Beginning at the start line, race half way through the block (stop inside taped off area), the beds must come to a complete stop in the taped off area and successfully complete a “ Chinese Fire Drill”, then continue to the end of the block. The bed must be completely stopped, the rider must exit the bed, jump rope 5 times, as the team turns the bed around and the rider gets back on the bed and race to the middle of the block (inside the taped off area) complete a “Chinese Fire Drill” successfully and continue to the finish line. Note: the drills are intended to slow down the race and are darn entertaining.*
- *All members of the team must be in contact with the bed at all times, except when jumping rope and during the “drill”.*
- *The rider must be on the bed as long as it is in motion and may not help at anytime in the propulsion of the bed. If the rider falls off, the bed must come to a complete stop until the rider is back on.*
- *This will be an “Elimination Race”. Two beds will race at once. Winners will race winners of another race, etc. The last winner of the final race will be declared the winner.*
- *All teams will need to display their name on the bed so that the audience may view it.*
- *Participants must decorate themselves and the bed to the theme.*
- *All beds must be removed by the team or sponsor at the end of the event. Including anything attached to the bed that has fallen off.*
- *Judge’s decision is final.*

BED CONSTRUCTION

- *The frame of the bed racer does not need to be of an original bed, but it must be real bed in appearance by having a headboard and footboard.*
- *Beds are to have a minimum of four wheels, so situated to make the bed race safe. Wheels must be no larger than 12” and may be a swivel, steering or permanently fixed. Note: fixed wheels are more than adequate.*
- *The bed cannot have any means of propulsion or brakes other than human runners. No Motors!*
- *Beds may not be pulled, only pushed from the sides and/or back.*
- *The bed may have push bars, though may not exceed the overall width of the bed.*
- *The mattress and/or box spring must be a manufactured adult sized bed either a double, queen or king. This will be strictly enforced. No youth beds, cribs or of the like.*
- *Mattress must be outfitted with one blanket and one pillow.*
- *Any violations of the bed construction guidelines will cost a team 5 seconds per violation at the start of the race.*
- *Note: One of the most fun parts of a bed race is building your own bed to use.*

***Bed Race Team Waiver
July 31, 2010***

All team members as well as any team sponsors must sign below accepting waiver of liability:

The sponsor and team members whose names appear below agree to protect, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the event holders namely the Johnson Creek Historical Society and Creek Fest Committee, Johnson Creek Chamber of Commerce and the Village of Johnson Creek (without any condition or obligation) for all claims, demand, suits, liabilities, damages, injuries, judgments, losses and expenses including without limitation, attorneys fees, that must be asserted against or incurred by event holders by or due to any person not a part to this agreement, including teams insurance company, for any expense, loss or damage, including without limitation, statutory civil damages, personal injury, death or property damage, real or personal, arising out of or from, in connection with, as a result of, related to or as a consequence of any aspect of the race, including preparation, participation, or culmination of said race. The participants fully understand that the devices that they will be using are not designed to be used in public streets, and that there are many inherent liabilities in the participation of such an event. The participants accept this liability willingly and agree to participate in a safe manner with respect to all other participants, officials and spectators.
